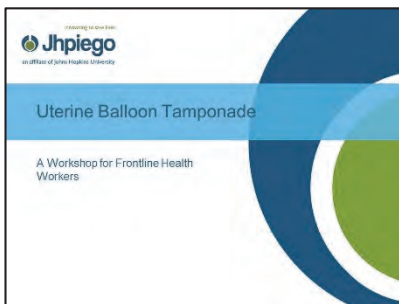


Uterine Balloon Tamponade Learning Resource Package

Uterine Balloon Tamponade (UBT) is a WHO recommended intervention for management of postpartum hemorrhage (PPH) when bimanual compression and uterotonic drugs have failed or are not available. When uterine tamponade is provided by assembling a condom and Foley catheter, it is both affordable and usually readily available. The device is inserted into the uterus and inflated with 250–500 mL normal saline to stop PPH. In many cases, use of the UBT eliminates the need for surgical intervention or allows for transfer to a higher level of care.

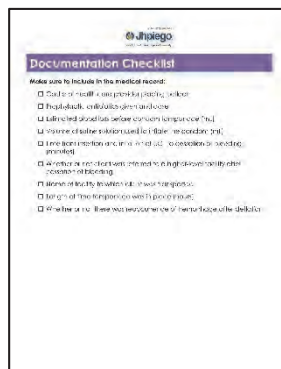
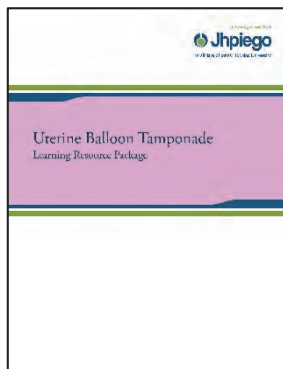

A 5 minute animated video on how to assemble and use the UBT.

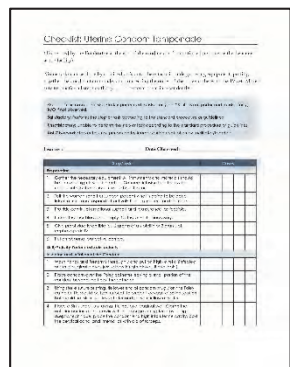

Training guide for learner and facilitator, includes PowerPoint presentations, job aid, knowledge assessment, and checklists.



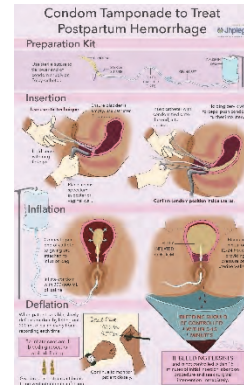
DOCUMENTATION CHECKLIST
